1. Introduction: (Brief History + Highlights; each in 3-4lines)

The College, affiliated to the Allahabad University was founded on the principles of Maharshi Dayanand Saraswati who was a social reformer and educationist. It was established in the year 1975, the International Year of Women, and was a Constituent College of Allahabad University on 14th July, 2005 the year the University achieved Central status.

The goals and objectives of the College, which is situated in the thickly populated area of the city, are focused towards education and empowerment of women specially from the backward areas. Our endeavour has been to promote independent thinking among young girls and make them responsible citizens so that they play the role of an anchor in their own families.

The College offers graduate degrees in Arts and Commerce, post graduate degree in Arts and will soon be starting courses in Five Year Integrated Law and Science. Doctoral programme is offered in Political Science, Education, Hindi, English, Sociology and Music Vocal.

2. Thrust Areas:(Point-wise)

- The College organize lectures by outstanding academicians. These lectures are very beneficial both for faculty
 members and students as exchange of ideas broadens the outlook of both the teachers and the students. The
 teachers update themselves with the latest information.
- The college library is a vital resource for Arya Kanya Degree College both supporting the curriculum and providing reading for pleasure. A new reading room for the library has been inaugurated in August 2022, which has increased the space for reading Currently three reading room is available. One is a small reading room for research scholars and Faculty members and two big halls are available for the students. The library is well equipped with 113 seating capacity. The library holds about 15500+ books, Journals, 3135800+ e-books (from NLIST), and 6200+ full text e-journals from NLIST. The library has been using the SOUL, an integrated Library Management software package with all the modules for the library housekeeping operations. Using WEB OPAC, users can search the library catalogue by Author, Title, Subject and Keywords from anywhere and any device. Library is well equipped with modern facilities, print and electronic resources in the forms of books, journals, reports, etc.
- Career counseling is given to the students from time to time by career experts. It is a process that helps the students
 to know and understand themselves and the world in order to make career, educational and life decisions. Many
 students get placements in various fields by taken our career counseling.
- We encourage sports and games both indoor and outdoor because physical exercise and training provide good health which is necessary for physical health and intellectual pursuits. Such activities cultivate a spirit of healthy competition among the students. Yoga and Meditation training through Heartfullness is also given to the students. Yoga is not a religion, it is a way of living and helps to promote a balanced development of physical, mental and spiritual well-being.
- Vocational and job-oriented courses enable the students to gain specific skills and recognition. Computer courses, fashion designing, beauty tips by experts, mehndi application helps the students acquire skills and thereby earn a livelihood for themselves and become economically independent.
- Participation of students in various competitions organized by the University and other degree Colleges like quiz, essay writing, debate, folk song, folk dance, mehndi, painting etc. enables the students to showcase their talents and develop a sense of confidence.
- The students of Fine Arts take participation in various competition and get prizes. College students participated in various competitions with the presentation of cultural programmes in various fields by the cultural committee and got the top position in the competitions.




